Community Health-Aides and Advanced Practice Providers are On-Call after-hours for emergencies only.

EMERGENCIES are those conditions that, if not treated very soon, could result in the loss of Life, Limb, Eyesight and/or Organ. If you are unsure, please contact the provider on-call who will evaluate your signs and symptoms. Some examples are:

- -Severe pain
- -Severe bleeding
- -Chest pain
- -Respiratory Distress/Severe shortness of breath
- -Motor vehicle accident
- -Serious burns
- -Sudden change in vision
- -Complications related to pregnancy
- -Poisoning (Poison Control Center 1-800-222-1222)

- -Head injury
- -Severe headache
- -Possible broken bone
- -Infant with fever over 101*
- -Open wounds
- -Acute smoke inhalation
- -Serious fall
- -Preterm labor or bleeding

Notice: For your safety and ours, emergency medical providers will respond to situations involving alcohol, drugs, weapons, environmental dangers or violence only when the scene is deemed safe by the Medical Provider and/or VPSO or other designated policing or safety personnel.
